## Common Entrance Survey Results: <br> IB/M Teacher Education Students Entering in 2013-2014

SEPTEMBER 2013
The Common Entrance Survey was administered to all incoming students enrolled in teacher education programs at the University of Connecticut's Neag School of Education in the fall of the 2013-14 school year. This report contains survey results based on responses of 91 students in the Integrated Bachelor's/Master's (IB/M) program., 75 of whom ( $82.42 \%$ ) are female.
$\checkmark \quad 82.4 \%$ of IB/M teacher education students are female.
$\checkmark$ Respondents are studying in the fields of Agriculture, Biology, Earth Science, Elementary Education, English Language Arts, General Science, Mathematics, Music, Social Studies, Special Education, and World Language. Elementary education is highest field of study (36.3\%)
$\checkmark$ The highest education level attained by $33.3 \%$ of students' mothers was at least a four-year college degree; similarly, $47.3 \%$ of students report their fathers' highest education level as four-year college degree.
$\checkmark$ Most respondents ( $96.7 \%$ ) attended a public high school.
$\checkmark$ Respondents want to more focus on their study in elementary and high school , respectively $37.9 \%$ and $35.0 \%$
